

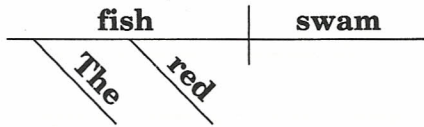
Adjective Modifiers

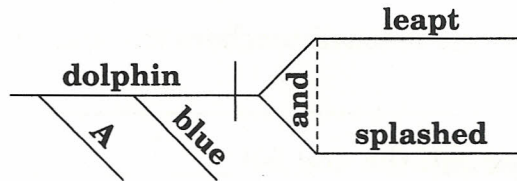
An adjective is placed on a slanted line beneath the noun that it modifies.

A blue dolphin leapt and splashed.



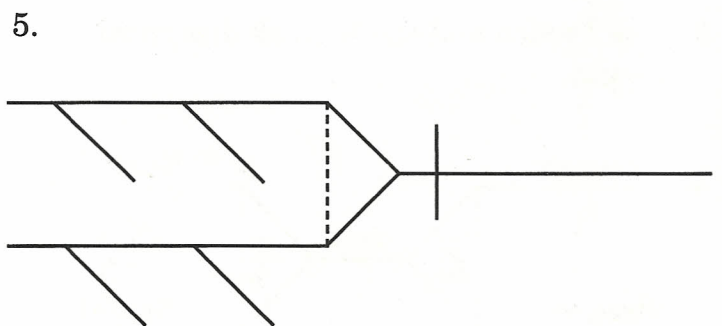
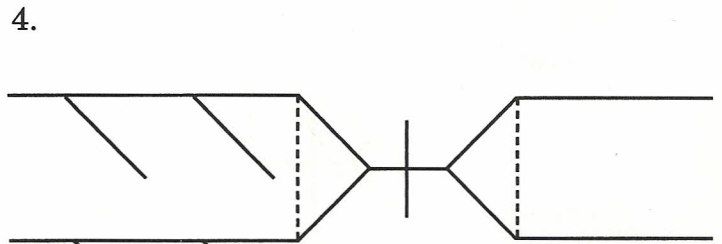
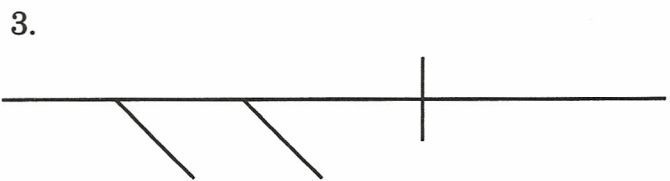
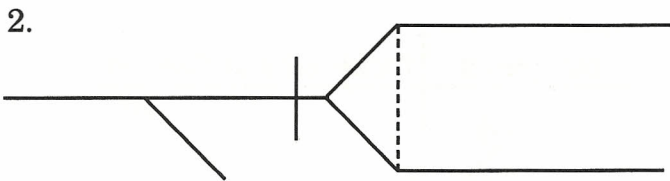
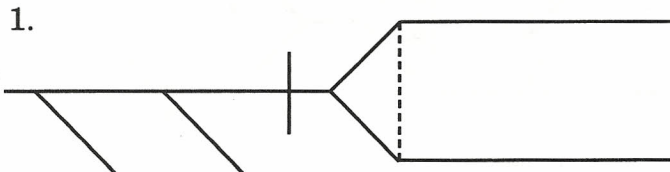
