CHAPTERS 1-2

ANSWERS

It was a "deep, sickening feeling of something terrible about to happen."

ANSWERS

They were taught to be careful about language.

ANSWERS

CHAPTERS 6-7

CHAPTERS 8-10

ANSWERS

The qualities were intelligence, integrity, courage, and wisdom.
